## FAST OF THE FIRST BORN

Because the first born of the Israelites were spared when the Egyptians were smitten in the tenth plague, all first-born Jewish males fast on *Erev Pesach* until the *Seder*. This is called *Ta'anis Bechorim*. If however one attends a *Se'udas Mitzvah*, (a feast that accompanies the performance of a religious duty), one is not required to fast.

It is, therefore, customary in all synagogues that a *Siyum* or conclusion of a Talmudic tractate follows the morning service on this day. The conclusion of a Talmudic book is an occasion of rejoicing and warrants a feast or *Se'udas Mitzvah*. The siyum will take place, please G-d, on Monday morning, April 22 at 8:00 A.M., on Zoom. Connection information will be forwarded.

Rabbi Bleich shall have full authority to arrange the terms and conditions of such disposal. I further authorize Rabbi Bleich to convey together with the aforesaid items a leasehold in any and all areas in which such items may be stored as well as the right of access to such items.
